

## Manufacturer Declaration Wood Preservatives

In the past wood preservatives such as Pentachlorophenol (PCP) and Lindane were used for the impregnation of wood and wood-based products. Nowadays, due to their well-known health hazards, these specific preservatives are highly regulated and no longer in use.

In the production of wood-based products, EGGER does not use wood preservatives, except for OSB with built-in termite protection.

However, due to the use of post-consumer recycling in particleboards, traces of these pollutants might still occur.

In Austria and Germany, maximum concentrations are limited by law. The German Waste Wood Ordinance and the Austrian Recycling Wood Ordinance define these thresholds.

Regular internal and external tests assure the recycling wood quality in every production plant, which is using post-consumer recycling material, also in plants not affected by the German and Austrian regulation.

**We hereby confirm that during the production of EGGER wood-based products, no wood preservatives are used, except for OSB with built-in termite protection. If post-consumer recycling material is used in the production, we are testing our boards regularly by external institutes.**
